Issues

- The NDC is **responsible** for proposing & implementing the NEMO Development Strategy
- Its **meetings** have:
 - included some management and scientific discussions
 - recently been attended by @20-30+ people
 - some Consortium and External experts do not attend and do not seem to have grasped their roles
- There is an **evolving** landscape
 - A Scientific Advisory Committee is being set up
 - The roles of NEMO Officers have recently been re-inforced
 - The NDC Preparatory Team is helping to prepare meetings

Roles

- **Consortium Expert**
 - To ensure interests of their institute are represented
 - So that Consortium members will support the NST Work Plan
 - Hence managers of ocean model teams in Consortium members
- **External Expert**
 - To ensure NEMO development choices & priorities are in line with scientific opportunities/needs in their field of expertise (sea-ice, HPC, dynamics, BGC, ...)
- **NEMO Officer**
 - To represent the members of the System Team in their institute (each System Team member is represented by a NEMO Officer)

Proposals

- External Experts
 - are welcome to attend the regular NDC meetings
 - but are not required to do so
 - and should bear in mind that detailed scientific discussions are more likely to take place in WGs;
 - are expected to attend meetings on NEMO Development Strategy
- Not to include all NST members as members of the NDC
 - The NEMO Officers will remain permanent members of the NDC
 - They can invite some other System Team members to attend who have specific interest or expertise in an agenda item
 - will assist discussions within NDC
 - reduces number of meetings NST members attend
